Please enclose a copy of the dog's ASCA registration with the entry.

Entry are due with entry and they have to be credited to ASCCG account (see above) latest July 6, 2019! Entries which are not payed in time will be canceled. There is NO payment reminder.

If the shows have to be cancelled due to outside conditions, ASCCG may withheld part of the paid entry fees to cover costs that may have been arose since then.

All current ASCA rules and regulations apply. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Rally/Obedience program, a dog or handler disqualified from All ASCA programs or a person not in good standing with ASCA. All dogs 6 months of age and over must have individual registrations to compete in all ASCA sanctioned events. Jr. Handlers must enter all required information. All entries must be on the new official ASCA entry forms with the agreement/disclaimer & signature on back. Incorrect and or missing information will invalidate entries.

Bitches in heat are for for both obidience and rally trials not allowed. In case bitch will be in heat for the trial weekend, please get in contact by show secretary of obidience/rally. Fee will be returned.

Third-Party Insurance:

All dogs entering the trial grounds must be insured against third-party risk.

Vaccinations:

You must show proof that your dog is current on its rabies vaccinations. Other vaccinations may be recommended. Be prepared to show your vaccination passports to veterinary officials of the city/county to be allowed on the show/trial grounds which applies also for all other dogs on the show grounds even if they will not compete! The rabies vaccinations must be at least 21 days old!

Class Order

Obedience

Utility: Utility B, Utility A (the order of exercises for Utility B will be posted in time on the grounds)

Open: Open B ODX, Open A ODX, Open B CDX, Open A CDX, (the order of exercises for Open B CDX/ODX will be posted in time on the grounds)

Novice: Novice B, Novice A

The long sit and down in Open and Novice might be combined for the B and A starters each according to the entries in each class. The order of group and single exercises in the Open and Novice classes will be posted on the grounds in time.

Novice Beginner: Novice Beginner B, Novice Beginner A

Rally

Masters: Masters C, Masters B, Masters A

Excellent: Excellent C, Excellent B, Excellent A

Advanced: Advanced C, Advanced B, Advanced A Novice: Novice C, Novice B, Novice A

Obedience/Rally:

Ribbons: 1st through 4th place

Qualifies: green Q ribbons for scores of 170 pts and more

Rosettes: HIT, HSJH, HCS

The award ceremony for each class Obedience and Rally will be held after the last starter in each class. The HIT (High in Trial) and if applicable HSJH (Highest Scored Junior Handler) and/or HCS (Highest Combined Score) will be awarded and the end of the trial.

Any healthy and trained dogs (Aussies, other breeds and also crossbreeds) 6 months or older are allowed to compete with an appropriate ASCA registration (individual, LEP or tracking no.). Bitches in heat are not allowed to compete!

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Behavior on the show ground:

- Please get the main grooming part done at home and use dirt bags at the showground.
- Any kind of dirt has to be removed by the creator resp. his owner! Please clean up after yourselves before you leave!
- Please keep a 1-2 m distance from the ring, make sure that no parts of your dogs (tails, legs) are in the ring, stop disturbing behavior of your dog/s immediately, don't play with or feed your dog directly at the ring.
- We have a photo corner at the show ground and you are of course welcome to take pictures of the dogs in the show ring – BUT PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE RING!
- All dogs (this INCLUDES puppies) have to be on leash while on the showground.
- If announcements are made, please listen to them and act accordingly.
- The ring entrance area is NOT for spectators but for the starters of the next class, judges and ring staff ONLY.
- The sale of dogs on the showground is forbidden

Please bring your own "attire" like "poop bags", trash bags, ash trays!

Third party insurance:

All dogs brought onto the show ground have to be included in third party insurance.

Authority as householder:

Your host, ASCCG has the authority as householder during the show. Please note that all things that block emergency exits and/or entries or are disturbing in any other way are to be removed immediately if we ask you to.

Hotels Freiburg and nearby:

You can find hotels and other accommodations under www.tourismus-kehdingen.de and/or www.tourismusverband-stade.de. Please inquire how many dogs are allowed, if additional costs will be charged and if there's a fee to be paid in case you have to cancel your reservation.

Parking/Camping:

There is enough space available for campers/trailers/tents. You can get price info from a member of staff of the community. Clean up after yourselves before you leave! Please note: Parking on your own risk.

Participation:

To attend our trials you do not have to be a member of ASCA®, ASCCG or any other club but we will not accept entries from dogs or handlers disqualified from the ASCA® program or a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA® programs or a person not in good standing with ASCA®.

Refund of Pre-entries & Class Changes:

You have to cancel starts in writing, we will refund 100% if you have to cancel your starts before Pre-entries closing date. No class changes will be made once entries have closed. After this date no refunds possible for any reason.

Refunds:

We will refund 100% if you have to cancel your starts later because of your bitch is in heat. Please cancel in writing and enclose a vet/doctor statement. 100% are also refunded if you cancel because of a judge's change!

Set-Up tents/pavilions:

We are planning to set up the ring and to block the spaces for vendor booths on Thursday around noon. Please wait with your own set-up until that is done.

Vet:

Name and contact information you'll receive when picking up your start numbers. There will probably be a vet present at the showground during the weekend, too.

Vendor booths:
